# Blacklist domains/mail addresses in SpamAssassin

Edit `/etc/spamassassin/v320.pre`

Uncomment the Shortcircuit line to enable it:

```
loadplugin Mail::SpamAssassin::Plugin::Shortcircuit
```

Edit `/etc/spamassassin/local.cf`

Add these lines to `local.cf` file:

```
ifplugin Mail::SpamAssassin::Plugin::Shortcircuit
shortcircuit USER_IN_BLACKLIST on
shortcircuit USER_IN_BLACKLIST_TO on
shortcircuit SUBJECT_IN_BLACKLIST onendif # Mail::SpamAssassin::Plugin::Shortcircuit
```

Include your blacklist file into `local.cf`:

```
include /etc/spamassassin/blacklist.cf
```

# Edit `/etc/spamassassin/blacklist.cf`

Add this line to block all emails from `domain.com`

```
blacklist_from *@domain.com
```

Add this line to block `addr@domain2.com`

```
blacklist_from addr@domain2.com
```

*You can add multiple domains and email accounts to block them.*

## Reload amavis

```
service amavis force-reload
```
